Thirty something Peter represents a new school breed of winemakers. He brings his youthful passion and ideas to the family business and to the winemaking itself. Peter has successfully captured what are quickly becoming hallmark wines of the Orange district- powerful yet restrained elegant flavours that are distinctively cool climate.

Greg, the oldest of the three kids, is creative director of one of Sydney's largest advertising agencies and is responsible for the label designs. The baby of the family, Kylie, is front person in the office and most importantly number one taster, spitting very little out!!

- **SAUVIGNON BLANC 2001**

A new comer to the Logan Wines range, the grapes for this white, like all the other wines in the Logan range come from the slopes of Mount Canobolas in Orange. Pale straw in colour with a green tinge, the fresh aroma is redolent of passionfruit, citrus and green mango. The palate zings with flavours of lemon, passionfruit and guava, exhibiting a long crisp finish.

- **CHARDONNAY 1999**

Pale straw in colour. The aroma shows citrus, (lemon and grapefruit) melon and custard apple characteristics. The palate is racy and features fresh grapefruit, melon and pomelo flavours. The finish is long and crisp.

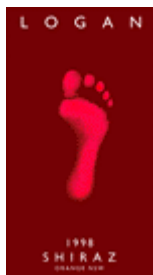

- **RESERVE CHARDONNAY 1999**

Named not because winemaker Peter Logan had any reservations about the grapes, but because he reserved the best grapes during production allowing them to ferment in French Oak barrels for 12 months. Pale straw in colour with a slight green hue, complex aromas of orange rind, grapefruit and cashew are present. Partial malo-lactic fermentation provides complexity, roundness and balance. The palate combines melon, fig and racy grapefruit, with a long, lingering finish.

- **SHIRAZ 1998**

Deep crimson in colour, the gentle oak influence provides clove, blackberry and smoky aromas. The finish is intense, with soft flavours of fruit cake, blood plum, cinnamon and spice. A colourful wine indeed.

Drink now or enjoy until about 2007 |



- **CABERNET SAUVIGNON 1998**

Rich red in colour with complex chocolate, boysenberry and rich toasty oak aromas. The palate is firm and shows earthy flavours of mint, plum, and tobacco.

Perfect for drinking now or cellar for up to 10 years |



- **LOGAN SPARKLING**

Keep an eye out for our Logan Sparkling. While it hasn't yet hit the shelves, it has already won a gold medal at the Rutherglen Wine Show and a very highly commended at the 2002 Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania Wine Show!
